Dr. Nico Keilman is a professor in the Department of Economics, University of Oslo, Norway. He is a leading expert on methods of demographic analysis and of population forecasting, household and family demography. Dr. Keilman is also editor of the international journal "Demographic Research" (<http://www.demographic-research.org/>) and a frequent reviewer for journals such as "Nature". He has a wide range of experience, including positions at Statistics Netherlands (1977-1981), Netherlands Interdisciplinary Demographic Institute (1982-1990), and Statistics Norway (1990-1998). Dr. Keilman received his MA in Applied Mathematics from Delft University of Technology and his PhD in Demography from the University of Utrecht.
